WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$2,600,500 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized of \$0; and authorized debt notes of \$2,602,500.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority, at an open public meeting held on November 10, 2009 that the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program of the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year beginning, December 1, 2009 and, ending, November 30, 2010 is hereby adopted and shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.

FISCAL YEAR: FROM DECEMBER 1, 2009 TO NOVEMBER 30, 2010

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget for the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year beginning, December 1, 2009 and ending, November 30, 2010 has been presented before the governing body of the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority at its open public meeting of September 17, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$7,434,548, including authorized debt notes of \$2,602,500, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$7,877,548 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets utilized of \$443,000; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$2,602,500 and Total Unrestricted Net Assets planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$0; and authorized debt of \$2,602,500; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority, at an open public meeting held on September 17, 2009 that the Annual Budget, including appended Supplemental Schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority for the fiscal year beginning, December 1, 2009 and ending, November 30, 2010 is hereby approved; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the anticipated revenues as reflected in the Annual Budget are of sufficient amount to meet all proposed expenditures/expenses and all covenants, terms and provisions as stipulated in the said Authority's outstanding debt obligations, capital lease arrangements, service contracts, and other pledged agreements; and

BE IT FURTHER RESQLVED, that the governing body of the Raritan Township Municipal Utilities Authority will consider the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program for adoption on November 19, 2009.

 - Total appropriations in the 2010 budget are \$222,429 lower than the 2009 budget, with a corresponding decrease in unrestricted net assets utilized of \$2,844,000. However, the Authority has authorized bond anticipation notes for capital projects in the amount of \$2,602,500.
- 2. Complete a brief statement on the impact the proposed Annual Budget will have on Anticipated Revenues, especially service charges and on the general purpose/component unit financial statements. Explain significant increases or decreases, if any.

The service charge per unit will remain the same as the prior year, \$420.00, annually, and billed quarterly.

Local economy not expected to impact the proposed 2010 budget.

The 2009 budget utilizes \$443,000 of unrestricted net assets to mitigate the effects of expense increases for operations and to help stabilize the user rate.
